

# JSTOR

JSTOR is an electronic database containing full text back issues of over 500 scholarly journals in the humanities, social sciences, and sciences.

To access JSTOR, go to the AMU Library's electronic resources page (<http://insideavemaria.org/library/resources.asp>) and click on JSTOR. Please note, from off-campus you must first login to the campus intranet for JSTOR to work.

On the main screen of JSTOR, the two main options are **Browse** and **Search**.

## BROWSE

Click on **Browse** to see a list of journals contained in the database, which can be organized either by academic discipline or alphabetically by title. After clicking on a journal title, choose a specific issue to view the table of contents. Click on the article you wish to read.

## SEARCH

Click on **Search** to find an article. **Basic Search** is the default mode and works just like an internet search engine such as Google. You may use quotes for exact phrases and the Boolean operators AND, OR, NOT to construct a search (see the separate handout on Boolean Operators for more on how they work).

Alternatively, click on **Advanced Search** for more options, including narrowing your search by academic discipline, type of material (article, book review, etc.), date, or journal.

Another option in the **Search** mode is **Article Locator**. Use this function when you know some information about a specific article such as the title, author, journal title, volume, or year and want to find the complete text of the article.

## OPTIONS ONCE YOU HAVE FOUND AN ARTICLE

Once you have found an article using either the Browse or Search option, you may View, **Print**, or **Save the Citation** for the article.

To view the article, simply click on the title. Click on **Article Information** to see all the information necessary for citing the article in a bibliography or footnote. Click on **Table of Contents** to see the rest of the articles published in the same issue of the journal as the article you are reading.

Click on **Print** and then **Proceed with Printing** to view the article in a printable pdf format.

Click on **Save Citation** to include the article in a list of articles you would like to come back to after searching for more articles. Click on **View Saved Citations** to see the list of citations you have saved.
